Scoring

Course – Map attached

The first mile is significantly different. The surfaces are primarily concrete and asphalt with about 400m on the track and about 600-700m on grass. We will start on the football field and end on the track.

Parking

Parking is available north (mauka) of the gym. No traffic will be allowed during races.

Tents may be set up in any grassy area that is not on the course. Please do not block stairs or walkways.

Buses
